



Bonnell announces price increases on added-value products.

The cost of manufacturing materials and supplies, particularly for paint, chemicals, and packaging, has increased dramatically this year and is expected to continue to increase in the coming months as a result of inflationary pressure most major commodities are experiencing.

Bonnell Aluminum has been very diligent in its cost reduction initiatives over the past 18 months and has achieved significant results. However, there is a point where cost reduction efforts alone can not absorb the entire burden. Therefore, Bonnell Aluminum is implementing price increases on the following products:

- Regular paint meeting AAMA 2603 specification:
 - 20% on perimeter inch size ranges under 10",
 - 15% on perimeter inch size ranges of 10" or greater.
- All anodizing finishes:
 - 20% on perimeter inch size ranges under 7",
 - 12% on perimeter inch size ranges 7" or greater.
- 15% on pour & debridge thermal barrier.
- Packaging for exterior protection:
 - \$0.09/lb for cartons, all sizes,
 - \$0.02/lb for paper, all sizes.

These price increases will be effective with new orders received on and after October 6, 2008.
